Introduction

This book is written to guide the reader through a vision of the last days — a series of events that, according to Scripture, may unfold before the return of Jezus Christ. It is not a declaration of absolute certainty. It is not a claim to replace the authority of the Bible. Rather, it draws from Scripture, prophetic dreams, and reflections on human experience to warn, alert, and prepare.

The chapters that follow take the reader through a sequence of events: darkness over the earth, the suffering of Christ, His resurrection, the ascension, and the return. These events are presented in the order suggested by biblical prophecy, primarily from the book of Revelation, alongside the Gospel accounts. The purpose is not to impose belief but to invite reflection on the seriousness and gravity of what is described.

This book plays many roles. At times, it acts as a witness, recounting what Scripture predicts. At others, it is a mirror, reflecting human choices and their consequences. It also functions as a record of visions and dreams, sharing what was revealed to the witness — experiences that cannot be fully verified, yet demand attention for what they reveal about faith, obedience, and discernment. Most importantly, it is a call to be prepared:

- To obey the commands of the Holy Spirit from within.
- To trust Christ as Lord over your life decisions, so that His remembrance is on you.
- To be mindful of the schemes of the devil, who works to blind humanity to reality and keep souls from salvation.
- To pay attention to the warnings in Scripture and prophetic dreams, which reveal both the sequence of events and the spiritual realities that often remain unseen.

This book is grounded in the reality that the Holy Bible is the military Word of God. The Bible is not a book of human opinion. It is a book of God's commands, orders, and strategy for life. God is not negotiating with humanity in the Bible. He is commanding. He is not expecting debate or argument. The Bible is not a democracy where you have a vote.

As Jezus says: *"Unless you repent, you will likewise go to hell fires."*

Repentance is at the core of this book. Those who rebel against the commands of the Holy Bible align themselves with Satan's rebellion and the punishment of eternal fire. If eternal fire were not the consequence of sin, Christ would have had no reason to come to earth. Let this not escape your attention.

Furthermore, the reader must understand the centrality of Christ in your personal life. Nothing — not politics, not family, not your job — can come before Him while you claim Him as Savior. Christ is not an after thought, not a weekly ritual, not a religious habit. Jesus must be at the center of everything you do.

Just as it is impossible to claim to truly love another human being while rejecting or ignoring and not recognizing Christ the source of Love you profess, it is impossible to claim His salvation while prioritizing earthly things. This is the deception of the last days — believing Christ can be an after thought while life continues according to human desires.

Ultimately, the message is simple: fear God and focus through Christ, walk with wisdom and awareness, and live in a way that honors Him in these last days. This book does not demand agreement; it does not claim to reveal everything. Its goal is to awaken discernment, vigilance, and readiness — to help the reader recognize truth when it comes, to distinguish between light and darkness, and to live in a way that is faithful, alert, and prepared for the moment when Christ returns.

Here, the reader is invited to watch, to meditate deeply in Christ in silence, stillness and quietude, and to reflect on what is written and revealed through truth. The witness presents these events not as an absolute timeline, but as a sober reminder that life as we know it is fleeting, that choices have consequences, and that the return of Christ will bring clarity, justice, and the fulfillment of prophecy in ways humanity cannot fully comprehend beforehand.

Chapter 1:

Birth of sin & evil in Heaven

In the ages before time was measured, when eternity lay silent like an unbroken sea of crystal, the heavens rejoiced in perfect harmony. All holy angelz moved in the light of the Eternal **Christ**, by whom “*all things were created*” (John 1:3).

Among the Angelic hosts , just like in the Milky Way Galactic system there are billions of stars , among them was Lucifer , chosen to be a general , among many other generals in the Angelic military ranks and formations of heaven.

Lucifer thou anointed cherub that covereth;and I have set thee so:thou wast upon the holy mountain of God;thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire.Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created,till iniquity was found in thee.”

Authority of the God in Christ Challenged

Sin does not begin with chaos.It begins with unauthorized power.

In *Star Trek: The Next Generation* (“Power Play”), Commander Riker is overtaken by a non-corporeal entity. The transformation is immediate—not merely behavioral, but ontological. His posture changes. His speech shifts. His relationship to authority is redefined.

He no longer addresses Captain Picard with respect.He uses Picard’s first name.He no longer submits — he challenges.This mirrors precisely the biblical account of Lucifer.

Lucifer's First Sin: A Change in Bearing. Lucifer does not fall by accident. He falls by repositioning himself.

- From servant to equal
- From obedience to evaluation
- From “under authority” to “authority itself”

Just as Riker's tone becomes condescending and self-assured, Lucifer's rebellion begins internally — a conviction that hierarchy is unnecessary when power is possessed. Pride does not announce itself as evil. It announces itself as *arrogance*.

The Strategy of Temptation: Power Without Submission

Possessed Riker does not demand loyalty through force. He tempts with upgrades.

- To Geordi: restored sight. To Wesley: instant maturity
- To Data: expanded capability. To Picard: replace you as captain
- This is the same strategy Lucifer employed in Heaven and later with humanity:

“You will not surely die... you will be like God.”

Power is offered without discipline. Ability is offered without obedience. Elevation is offered without authority. This is the core of lies and temptation.

Data's Refusal: The Gospel of Discernment

Data's response is the most Biblical precise moment in the episode: He refuses to build *one lie on top of another*. Data understands a principle many humans ignore: You cannot use lies to reach the truth.

This mirrors the faithful angels who refused Lucifer's proposal. They did not debate benefits. They did not negotiate terms. They recognized that any power detached from the rightful authority of Jesus Christ is illegitimate, no matter how attractive. Discernment is not emotional. It is structural.

The Temptation to Leave Christ's Lawful Authority

Riker's entity urges the crew to follow *him* instead of Picard. This is a crucial point. Lucifer's rebellion is not about independence — it is about replacing rightful authority. The call is always:

- *"I Lucifer can do a better job being on the throne?."*
- *"Are military protocols & hierarchy necessary?."*
- *"Why do I have to even take orders from Christ?"*

In Heaven, this meant rejecting God's order. On the Enterprise, it meant abandoning Picard's command. In both cases, the test is the same: Will you remain loyal to Christ when the devil invites you to sin and rebel?

Why All Refused — and Why Some Angels Fell

Every crew member refuses Riker's offer — not because the offer lacked appeal, but because they recognized illegitimacy. Lucifer's rebellion, likewise, did not deceive all angels.

It divided them. Some aligned to Lucifer's thinking saw power. Others aligned with Christ's command saw lawlessness. Those who fell did not misunderstand Lucifer's power — they underestimated the gravity and consequences of his rebellion.

The Birth of Evil Defined

Evil is the absence of the light of Christ. It is the insubordination to the authority of Jesus.

- Intelligence without wisdom
- Power without accountability
- Freedom without restraint

This is why Lucifer's fall is permanent: Because repentance is impossible — and repentance would require remorse, and his pride refuses to humble himself. "Power Play" is gospel truth. It is a biblical reenactment:

An angelic being acquires power. Authority is questioned. Temptation is personalized. Allegiance is tested. Pride reveals itself. The birth of sin in Heaven followed this same pattern. And the lesson is timeless: Power that asks you to abandon the rightful authority of Christ is already evil.

This is how evil begins — quietly, persuasively, confidently — and this is why Christ places such weight on obedience, humility, and discernment to His Father's will within you.

The Anatomy of a Coup d'état

A military coup d'état does not begin with tanks in the streets. It begins with a thought in the mind of an angel or soldier. A general who once served faithfully reaches a point where he decides:

- *"I no longer recognize this authority."*
- *"I could lead better."*
- *"The system is flawed, and I am the solution."*

From that moment, the chain of command is no longer seen as lawful—it becomes an obstacle. The general does not announce rebellion openly. He begins by manufacturing grievances: Questioning leadership competence. Amplifying real or perceived injustices. Reframing loyalty as blindness. Casting obedience as weakness.

He approaches other generals and officers quietly, not with open defiance, but with *concern*: "For the good of the nation... for stability... for the future..." This coup is necessary and crucial: a rebellion always cloaks itself in righteousness.

Convincing the Ranks: Loyalty Tested

Soldiers are not first asked to overthrow authority. They are asked to reinterpret it. Loyalty to heaven is considered unlawful. Loyalty to Christ is labelled weakness. Discipline is called lack of freedom. Once enough officers accept this reframing, command fractures. Authority is no longer singular. Allegiance becomes divided. At that point, force is no longer defensive—it becomes assertive. A coup is not chaos; it is organized insubordination.

Blind Allegiance to the Devil .

Blind allegiance to Satan does not begin with hatred of the authority of Christ. It begins with misplaced trust. Across history, Scripture, and even popular narrative, the same structure appears:

- A respected figure gains your trust
- That trust begins to override higher authority
- Loyalty activates before discernment
- Obedience is redirected—not rejected outright, but *reassigned*
- This is not rebellion in tone. It is a rebellion in structure. And

Scripture judges structure, not sentiment. The Star Wars Parallel —

Anakin Skywalker and Palpatine Anakin Skywalker did not fall because he hated the Jedi at first. He fell because he started to entertain the voice of the devil. Palpatine:

- Did not present himself as an enemy
- Positioned himself as a mentor
- Spoke with empathy, patience, and apparent wisdom
- Framed his guidance as *necessary* and *protective*

Anakin's error was not instant treason. It was progressive allegiance. Palpatine was busy reshaping the thinking of Anakin to reflect the image of the beast -the dark side. Anakin is basically a metaphor for who have not accepted Christ and are under the control of the serpent
